## Monthly Feature – Stabilized Approach & Go-Around

#### Submitted by General Aviation Joint Steering Committee (GAJSC) Loss of Control (LOC) Work Group

Many general aviation accidents have resulted from loss of control and/or collision with obstacles or terrain during approaches for landing. Other accidents continue to occur resulting from pilots' failure to execute timely go-arounds. GAJSC accident studies suggest that stabilized approaches are highly effective in reducing the number and severity of loss of control events. The GAJSC also contend that executing a timely go-around when approaches become unstable or runways become unusable reduces the likelihood of loss of control events.

#### Stabilized Approach Recommendations

- Non-stabilized approaches are one of the leading causal factors of Loss of Control accidents.
- A Stabilized Approach is defined as on the correct flight path with only small corrections required, on speed +10/-5 knots, on glide slope / VASI or constant rate of descent not above 1000 fpm, in the landing configuration, and Landing checklist complete.
- For IFR Flight it is recommended that you be stabilized at 1000 feet above touchdown elevation
- For VFR Flight it is recommended that you be stabilized by 500 feet above touchdown elevation
- Do not try to "salvage an approach" if not stabilized by 500 or 1000 feet GO-AROUND!
- Know your Go-around and Missed Figure 8-22. *Stabilized approach.* Approach procedures and practice them so you can make a timely confident decision.





Figure 8-23. Unstabilized approach.


