### **Monthly Feature - Safety Wire**

Submitted by General Aviation Joint Steering Committee (GAJSC) Loss of Control (LOC) Work Group

Failure to properly secure aircraft components has led to system and component failures. Some of those failures have compromised powerplant and control system operation resulting in crashes.

Because improper or absent aircraft component safety wiring continues to cause accidents, pilots and mechanics should carefully inspect for proper component assembly security.

### **Safety Wire**

- Pilots and mechanics should note component safety provisions during inspections.
- Safety wire and devices must be properly installed in order to be effective.
- There are two methods of safety wiring:
  - o Double-twist method (most common)
  - o Single-wire method used on screws, bolts and/or nuts in a closely-spaced or closed-geometrical pattern.
    - Single-wire method may also be used on parts in electrical systems & in difficult to reach places.
- Safety wire should be installed so that tension is applied in the component tightening direction.
- · Castellated nuts should have cotter keys installed.
- At least 1/32 inch of bolts should protrude from fiber lock nuts.
- A near-fatal accident occurred on May 27, 2018 at Houston
   Executive Airport in Katy Texas. Examination after the accident
   revealed the left aileron actuation arm and attach bolt were
   missing. Further investigation indicated that the safety wire was

### **Maryland Aircraft Tax Exemption Becomes Law**

As of July 1, 2020, Maryland pilots no longer have to pay 6% sales tax on aircraft parts and components! Maryland has become the 10<sup>th</sup> state in the Eastern region to pass a sales exemption tax (S.B. 121).







